We also had parents asking about after program ski groups. New this year beginning in January we will be offering supervised free skiing sessions Saturday and Sunday afternoons. The athlete's goals will be to gain mileage on their skis all over the mountain in a variety of conditions. Coaches will meet athletes in front of the Competition Center at 2:00. This program is not available for U8's. Athletes should come prepared for lightly supervised, directed free skiing with their peers. For this to be successful, the expectation is to be respectful of each other and have fun.

Over the summer, Mount Sunapee did maintenance on all of the lifts and replaced some less efficient snow guns with new, more productive snow guns that can make snow in higher temperatures (27 degrees vs 22 degrees). We also hired a firm that specializes in parking optimization to help us with parking and arrival strategies. The water system that fed the base area since 1962 was replaced with double the capacity in holding tanks and new pumps. You cannot see it but it was crucial to operations as that system feeds all the base are buildings for all water needs.
